The Anatomy of the Crazy Time Wheel

Understanding the Betting Options

1. Number Bets (1, 2, 5, 10)

- **Number 2:** Offers a 2:1 payout and covers almost a quarter of the wheel.
- **Number 5 and Number 10:** These represent higher-risk, higher-reward number segments. They appear less frequently however provide much better returns when struck.

2. Reward Game Bets

The perk rounds are the main tourist attraction of *Crazy Time*. To participate in a bonus offer round, a gamer needs to have an active bet positioned on that specific bonus section. If the wheel lands on a bonus video game and the player has not placed a bet on it, they can just watch the other gamers win.

- **Coin Flip:** An easy 50/50 design mini-game including a red and blue coin with multipliers.
- **Pachinko:** A physical drop-board where a puck falls pegs to land in a multiplier slot.
- **Cash Hunt:** A shooting gallery featuring 108 random multipliers concealed behind interactive targets.
- **Crazy Time:** The supreme perk round, opening a virtual door to a colossal secondary wheel with massive multipliers as much as 20,000 x.

The Role of the Top Slot

Adding an extra layer of enjoyment to every single spin is the **Top Slot**. Located straight above the primary money wheel, this two-reel slot spins all at once with every round.

- The left reel chooses a bet area (a number or a benefit game).
- The right reel picks a random multiplier (ranging from 2x approximately 50x).

If the Top Slot successfully matches the winning sector on the primary wheel, the multiplier is used either to the winning number payout or to the multipliers inside the subsequent reward video game. This mechanic is vital for those seeking to optimize their prospective returns when they bet Crazy Time.

- **The Bonus Hunter Approach:**
 - Ignores the numbers completely.
 - Places simultaneous bets on all four reward rounds (*Coin Flip*, *Pachinko*, *Cash Hunt*, and *Crazy Time*).
 - High volatility; relies completely on striking benefit rounds often enough to offset the continuous losses on non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
