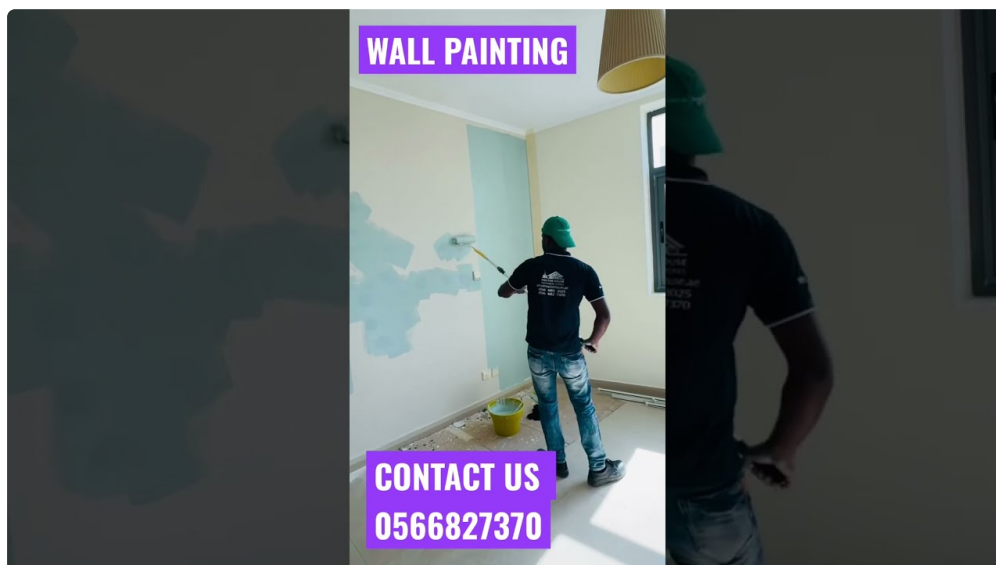

We sprayed a committed adhesion primer, sanded to 320, then sprayed two coats of a waterborne alkyd satin. Doors held on day 4, with bumpers mounted to ward off sticking. The proprietor waited a week earlier than loading shelves. Total time, eight working days with a 4 consumer staff, simply over 400 linear toes of trim, 17 doors, and 34 cabinet pieces. Three months later, we did a courtesy fee. No blocking, no sags, and the stairwell appeared flat at sundown.

Coordinating with different trades and your calendar
