#### Estimated CS2 Case Drop Probabilities

- **Blue (Mil-Spec):** ~ 79.92%
- **Purple (Restricted):** ~ 15.98%
- **Pink (Classified):** ~ 3.20%
- **Red (Covert):** ~ 0.64%
- **Special Rare (Knives/ Gloves):** ~ 0.26%

*Note: Within each tier, there is an additional 10% possibility to receive a **StatTrak**™ variant, which tracks the variety of eliminates made with that weapon.*

- **Cons:** High risk of losing cash; most openings result in low-value blue or purple products.
