Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time efficiently, players must initially understand the betting layout. The 54 sectors on the wheel are divided into number bets and benefit game bets. Each sector uses various payout potentials and likelihoods.

Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payment: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payout: 5:1
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payment: 10:1

Perk Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.

- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before each and every single spin of the primary wheel, a tiny two-reel fruit machine situated above the primary wheel spins simultaneously.



- **How it Works:** The left reel shows among the betting alternatives (numbers or perk video games), while the right reel displays a multiplier (ranging from 2x up to 50x).
- **The Result:** If the symbol on the left reel matches the outcome of the main wheel spin, the multiplier is used to that win. If it indicates a perk video game, the multiplier uses to all multipliers inside that specific reward round.

Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic of the video game takes place when the wheel lands on one of the 4 bonus segments. Players who have actually positioned a bet on that specific bonus offer round are transferred to a secondary game screen, where huge multipliers await.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the four reward rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a machine. Before the flip, random multipliers are designated to both sides of the coin. Whichever side lands deal with up figures out the gamer's payout.

- **Bonus function:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some cases be activated, offering players another possibility at higher benefits.

2. Money Hunt

Gamers are provided with a huge interactive screen displaying a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers concealed behind numerous signs (like a cactus, target, or sheriff's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to intend and contend one sign before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all symbols reveal their surprise multipliers, and the player is awarded the multiplier they strike.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko features a big wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck waterfalls downward, it bounces arbitrarily off the pegs before landing in one of a number of multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck lands on a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

The supreme bonus offer round. Gamers stroll through a red door into a surreal, virtual world including a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- **The Gameplay:** The player (or the host, depending upon the video game variation) selects one of three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel also includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, allowing lucky players to set off astronomical wins up to the video game's cap of 20,000 x.

Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is fundamentally a video game of chance determined by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, gamers frequently employ various techniques to handle their bankroll and make the most of home entertainment.

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
 - Focus primarily on wagering numbers 1 and 2, which make up a big part of the wheel. This technique yields regular, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll steady and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread small bets across all 4 bonus offer rounds while sometimes backing number 10. This ensures eligibility for the high-paying reward video games without draining funds too rapidly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets solely on the benefit rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This design requires persistence and a larger bankroll, as droughts can happen, but it uses direct access to the video game's greatest potential payouts.

Best Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed total up to invest before beginning the video game and never chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that perk bets generally have a slightly lower RTP than easy number bets, indicating they are greater risk, higher reward.
