Flickering lights are not a cosmetic inconvenience; they signal loose connections that create sustained electrical arcs. Constantly tripping breakers mean a circuit is overloaded and the protective system is doing its job, but only barely. If that breaker ages or if someone tampers with it by installing a larger one to stop the nuisance, you've created a catastrophic exposure where fire can start without warning.

Aluminum connections corrode and loosen over decades, creating the exact fire hazard that copper wiring avoids. An electrician's callout to diagnose and replace corroded aluminum connections—a job that may cost \$200 to \$500 depending on scope—prevents a fire that could destroy everything you own. What Specific Fire Hazards Does a Professional Electrician Identify During a Callout?

Federal Pacific Stab-Lok electrical panels, installed in many Oklahoma City homes built in the 1970s and 1980s,

are a documented fire hazard and should be replaced immediately; a professional assessment during a callout will confirm whether your home has one. Similarly, two-prong outlets indicate ungrounded wiring, which creates both shock hazard and reduced fire protection because the ground path is missing.

The fire risk from these conditions is not always visible to the homeowner. A breaker that trips repeatedly may be hiding an arcing fault inside the wall, a situation where electricity is jumping across a gap and heating the surrounding material to ignition temperature. An outlet that seems normal to use might have a loose wire connection inside that you cannot see but an electrician can confirm with diagnostic equipment. Flickering lights that come and go are especially deceptive because they suggest an intermittent problem, but intermittent arcing is precisely how fires start in hidden locations.

These are significant investments, but they are vastly smaller and far less traumatic than the cost of a fire and its aftermath.
