3. Essential Tips for Long-Term Success

Research, Research, Research

Never ever bet on a match where you haven't inspected the current head-to-head records. Websites like HLTV.org are the market standard for statistics. Look for "Recent Form," which tracks how groups carried out in their last 5-10 series.

Handle Your Bankroll

The most typical error gamblers make is "tilting"-- positioning emotional bets to recover losses.

- **The 2% Rule:** Never bet more than 2% of your overall bankroll on a single match.

4. The Psychology of Live Betting

Live betting is where the action shifts. Unlike pre-match betting, where you depend on data, live wagering counts on **checking out the flow**.

1. **Momentum Shifts:** In CS: GO, momentum is everything. If a group wins a "force-buy" round where they were out-equipped, their confidence will skyrocket. That is frequently the finest time to wager on them to take the next round.
