Mountain cabin, tough-sawn pine. South elevation baked. We adopted spray with aggressive lower back-rolling. At yr

four, the north wall looked like day one. The south became carrying predictably, but frivolously, with a preservation coat forecast for yr six or seven.

Old coatings have been peeling in sheets. We moisture-tested the wall, discovered trapped vapor from a downspout leak, fixed drainage, then used an alkali-resistant primer and a breathable silicone-more desirable topcoat. The adjacent dental tenant employed us later for ceiling painting features and wall painting prone when they saw the external preserve by two winters.
