That will shatter a brittle resin and open seams around drains. In freezer rooms, repeated freeze-thaw cycles do their personal gradual work, enormously if the slab used to be now not appropriate insulated.

Moisture migration pushes upward year circular in a few geographies. Any coating on the wrong aspect of a excessive vapor power will blister. Polished concrete and breathable tactics journey out this limitation more gracefully than tight motion pictures.
