2. The Split-Bet Strategy (The Best of Both Worlds)

- **How it works:** Utilize the two-bet feature. Set Bet 1 to cash out early (e.g., at 2.0 x) to secure an ensured return covering both stakes, and let Bet 2 run longer to chase after a high multiplier.
