2. Steam Community Market

For specific cases that are no longer in the active drop pool, players turn to the Steam Community Market. Prices vary based upon supply and demand.

3. Third-Party Trading Platforms

Many traders utilize reputable third-party sites to buy and sell cases utilizing real-world fiat currency or cryptocurrencies, typically bypassing the Steam Wallet funds restriction.

CS2 Case Drop Pools

Comprehending where a case sits in the drop hierarchy assists players choose whether to keep cases as financial investments or open them.

- **Classified (Pink):** ~ 3.20%
- **Covert (Red):** ~ 0.64%
- **Special Item (Knives/ Gloves):** ~ 0.26%

Note: There is also approximately a 10% chance that any dropped weapon will feature a "StatTrak" module, which tracks the number of eliminates made with that specific weapon.
