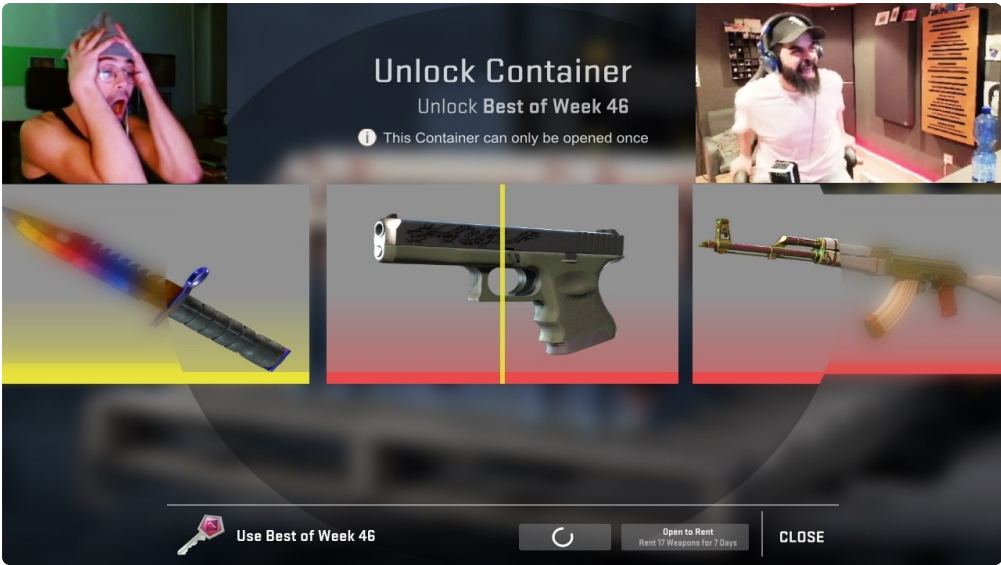
Product Rarity	Approximate Drop Rate
Mil-Spec (Blue)	~ 80%
Restricted (Purple)	~ 15%
Classified (Pink)	~ 4%
Covert (Red)	~ 0.65%
Rare Special Item (Knife)	~ 0.26%

Note: The specific likelihood for a particular knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a fraction of the rare unique item pool.

These numbers show that the frustrating bulk of openings will produce standard skins, [case opening](#) not knives. The low likelihood makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

Popular Knife Types and Market Values
