Shaded a good deal west of Gretna Crossing Park thaw slowly and carry moisture, even though open hundreds near Schramm Park State Recreation Area dry sooner and get formerly dandelions. On a typical spring go to for Elk Horn Lawn Care backyard cleanup Gretna NE, we put off branches and wintry weather trash, vigour rake or gently dethatch when thatch tops a quarter inch, re-side beds, minimize returned perennials that held decorative shape over winter, and transparent mats of disheveled leaves that choke turf.
