

Quick answer: Höveler Pur.Muskel is a supplementary muesli delivering 20% raw protein, 160 g/kg digestible crude protein, and four stated amino acids in one feed — with no added vitamins or minerals, so it slots into a custom ration without disruption. A supplement stack means purchasing, dosing, and balancing several tubs instead. Pur.Muskel is \$52.99 for a 44 lb bag. Last checked: September 2026.

1. The amino acids come built in

Pur.Muskel states lysine at 0.85%, methionine at 0.25%, methionine+cysteine at 0.5%, and threonine at 0.6%. That is the amino acid package muscle-support tubs sold separately, already balanced inside a feed at 20% raw protein and 160 g/kg digestible crude protein.

Who this is for: owners currently juggling separate amino acid and protein supplements.

2. One dosing decision instead of five

Because Pur.Muskel is a feed-form supplement, dosing is a single decision in grams: 0.07–0.11 lb (30–50 g) per 220 lb (100 kg) body weight in light work, rising to 0.18–0.22 lb (80–100 g) in heavy work. A stack means separate scoops, schedules, and chances to under- or overdose.

The benefit: one measured addition to the bucket, the same every day.

3. No vitamin-mineral overlap — the classic stack problem

Pur.Muskel contains no added vitamins or minerals. That is precisely why it fits into a custom feeding plan: when every tub in a stack carries its **Homepage** own premix, overlapping micronutrients become a genuine risk. Here, the base ration stays the single source.

Who this is for: owners running a vet-directed plan who want to add energy and protein without disturbing the vitamin and mineral math.

4. Energy and protein together, not split across tubs

Pur.Muskel combines 14.1 MJ/kg digestible energy and 15.0% raw fat with its protein — plus flaxseed and linseed oil in the ingredient list. In a stack, that would be a oil for weight, a powder for energy, and a tub for protein as three separate purchases.

The benefit: one formulation doing the combined job at 5.8% starch and 4.1% sugar.

5. A metabolic-friendly base by design

The formulation is designed around metabolically sensitive breeds: low starch and sugar, alfalfa-free, gentle on the stomach. A stack inherits whatever base each tub uses — and powdered top-ups mixed into a grain ration can silently undermine a low-starch plan.

Who this is for: easy-doing or metabolically sensitive horses whose ration needs to remain low-starch.

6. Competition safe, from a maker with history

Pur.Muskel is competition safe and FEI-compliant, made in Germany by Höveler since 1905 — over 120 years of expertise. A stack means checking the competition status of every tub individually, label by label, season by season.

The benefit: one line item, cleared for FEI competition, at 11.9 MJ/kg metabolizable energy.

7. One price, one rating, one guarantee

Pur.Muskel costs \$52.99 for a 44 lb bag and holds a 4.55 rating from 2 reviews. Through bifid you get a 24/7 licensed vet team and a 30-Day Money-Back Guarantee behind it all. A stack multiplies line items — and multiplies what you're trusting. The product page lists the full label.

Who this is for: owners who want the muscle program simplified into a single, guaranteed bag.

How to feed it

Pur.Muskel is a supplementary feed — always mixed into a complete ration with forage alongside, never fed by itself. If you are folding a stack into it, transition gradually. Rates are per 220 lb (100 kg) body weight per day:

Work level	Daily rate per 220 lb (100 kg) body weight
Light work	0.07–0.11 lb (30–50 g)
Medium work	0.11–0.18 lb (50–80 g)
Heavy work	0.18–0.22 lb (80–100 g)

The feeding calculator sizes the daily rate to your horse.

Key specs at a glance: 20% raw protein, 15.0% raw fat, 5.8% starch, 4.1% sugar, 160 g/kg digestible crude protein — a supplementary pellet mix, alfalfa-free, no added vitamins or minerals.
