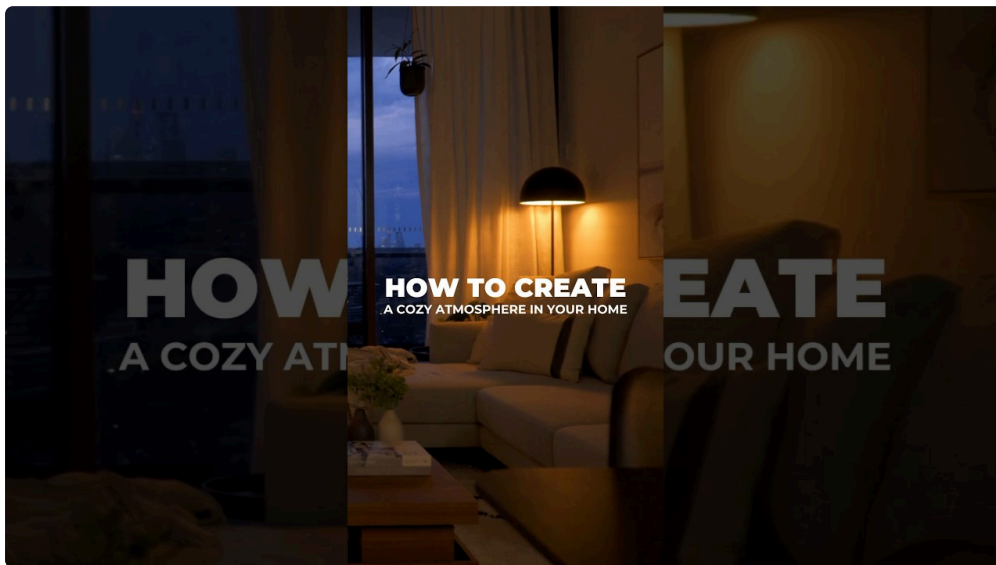
The installer matters more than the brand name
