(Note: These portions apply to the base item tier. If an item drops, there is an extra 10% chance that it will include StatTrak innovation, which lowers the base chances of getting a particular item version even further.)

To put these numbers into viewpoint, the chance of unpacking a rare, high-tier Knife or pair of Gloves is approximately **1 in 385**.

Understanding Float Values and Conditions

Even if a player beats the chances and lands a high-tier product, the fight is just half won. Every weapon dropped from a case is designated a **Float Value**-- a number in between 0.00 and 1.00 that figures out the wear condition of the skin.

The wear conditions are categorized as follows:

- **Factory New (FN):** 0.00-- 0.07
- **Minimal Wear (MW):** 0.07-- 0.15
- **Field-Tested (FEET):** 0.15-- 0.37
- **Well-Worn (WW):** 0.37-- 0.45
- **Battle-Scarred (BS):** 0.45-- 1.00

Various skins have different wear limits. Some skins can not be acquired in Factory New condition, suggesting the top-tier float values are extremely rare and command massive rates on the Steam Community Market.

Why Do Players Keep Opening Cases?

With such daunting odds, why is the case-opening economy worth billions of dollars? The psychology behind CS: GO case odds relies heavily on cognitive biases.

- **The Near-Miss Effect:** Watching the cursor slowly tick past a Gold product and arrive on a low-cost Blue item sets off the exact same mental reaction in the brain as a win, encouraging another effort.
- **Variable Reward Schedules:** Much like a slot maker, the unpredictability of the reward keeps gamers engaged. You never know *when* the payment will take place, just that it *might* take place on the next shot.
- **The Investment Illusion:** Some gamers see case opening as an investment, intending to pull an unusual item that will appreciate in worth over time.
