

Garage Door Repair Services in Woodland Hills

- **Bent garage door panel:** A vehicle impact, wind damage, or long-term wear can bend or crack a garage door panel. Damage may keep the door from moving properly.
- **Garage door opener malfunction:** The motor may hum without moving the door, stop responding to controls, or operate sporadically.
- **Garage door track issues:** Bent tracks, loose fasteners, or poor alignment can cause grinding, jerky movement, or rollers that leave the track.
- **Worn rollers and cables:** Noisy operation, uneven movement, or visible fraying can suggest the need for garage door roller replacement or garage door cable repair.

Do not force a stuck door or attempt to remove a spring under tension. These components can store considerable energy. A licensed garage door technician has the tools and training to isolate the problem safely.

When You Need Garage Door Spring Replacement

Garage door spring replacement is one of the most common repairs in Woodland Hills. Springs balance the weight of the door so the opener does not have to lift the full load. If a spring breaks, the door may become too heavy for manual operation and continuing to use the opener can cause additional damage.

Most residential systems use either a **torsion spring** mounted above the door or one or more **extension spring** assemblies positioned alongside the horizontal tracks. The correct replacement depends on the door's weight, height, track configuration, and hardware. A qualified technician should replace springs as a matched set when appropriate and inspect cables, drums, bearings, and brackets at the same time.

Issues With the Garage Door Opener and Remote

Opener problems are often not due to a failed motor. Start with a few simple checks: confirm that the opener has power, replace the batteries in the garage door remote, and make sure the wall switch is neither locked nor damaged. If the remote works but the wall switch does not, or if the wall switch works while the remote fails, the issue may involve remote programming, the wiring, or the control board.

Blocked or misaligned garage door safety sensors can also prevent the door from closing. These small devices are usually positioned near the bottom of the tracks. They must be aimed at each other and have a unobstructed view. Do not bypass them; they are an key part of the opener's safety system.

Garage door opener installation may be worthwhile when an older motor is noisy, lacks modern safety features, or cannot handle the door's weight. The garage door opener installation cost depends on motor strength, drive system, available ceiling height, required electrical work, remotes, keypad controls, and the condition of the existing door. A technician should verify that the door is balanced before installing a new opener.
