What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino video game developed around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The game is hosted by a live, energetic presenter who spins the wheel, communicates with the audience via live chat, and guides players through the numerous sections.

What sets Crazy Time apart from standard wheel games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a top slot placed straight above the main wheel. With every spin, the top slot spins all at once, creating a random multiplier for a particular bet area. If the wheel stops on that area and a reward or number is increased, gamers can win astronomical payouts.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay standard cash prizes) and perk rounds (which activate minigames). Understanding the circulation of these segments is important for managing bankrolls and comprehending the video game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can place bets on 4 various numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number corresponds to its payout multiplier if the wheel arrive on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (greatest frequency, least expensive payout of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payout of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).

- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payout of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The true excitement of Crazy Time lies in its four bonus rounds. These inhabit a combined total of 9 sections on the wheel, making them rarer to strike, but greatly more rewarding.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 segments on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sectors on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 segments on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 segment on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a reward segment, all players who positioned a bet on that particular bonus offer round are carried to a different, immersive set (or increased truth screen) to get involved.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the bonus rounds, Coin Flip involves a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is appointed a random multiplier by the game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to turn the coin, and whichever side lands deal with up awards the player that matching multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can often be set off for a second opportunity.

2. Pachinko

Inspired by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, the Pachinko benefit round includes a huge wall filled with physical pegs. The video game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces randomly down through the pegs till it lands in one of the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive at a **"Double"** value, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped once again for even higher stakes.

3. Money Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Players exist with a massive screen showing 108 random multipliers concealed behind various symbols (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).



- Players use an on-screen crosshair to objective and "shoot" their selected sign before the timer runs out.
- Once time expires, all symbols expose their covert multipliers, and players get the multiplier attached to their selected target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the video game is the Crazy Time bonus round. Players stroll through a red door into a lively, virtual wonderland featuring an enormous, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, gamers must pick among three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow.**

- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flapper indicate is granted to the gamer.
- Much like Pachinko, this wheel features **"Double"** and **"Triple"** segments. If the flapper arrive on one of these, the multipliers on the wheel boost, and the wheel is spun again-- possibly pressing payments up to the game's maximum limit of **20,000 x**.

Key Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is essentially a video game of opportunity powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, players typically adopt particular betting strategies to manage their risk and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on wagering on numbers 1 and 2, while placing little hedge bets on bonus rounds. This method yields frequent, smaller wins and keeps the bankroll steady.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets solely on the 4 bonus offer rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility strategy developed for players who want to experience the minigames as often as possible, accepting that they may experience droughts of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all four bonus offer rounds proportionally. This makes sure that almost every spin of the wheel yields some kind of return or activates a feature.

Essential Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a set bankroll before logging in and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have slightly various Return to Player portions. Number bets typically use a higher statistical RTP than reward bets, however bonus offer bets use the enjoyment of huge multipliers.
- **Enjoy the Show:** Crazy Time is created as entertainment first. Treat the possible winnings as a bonus offer to the interactive, game-show experience.
