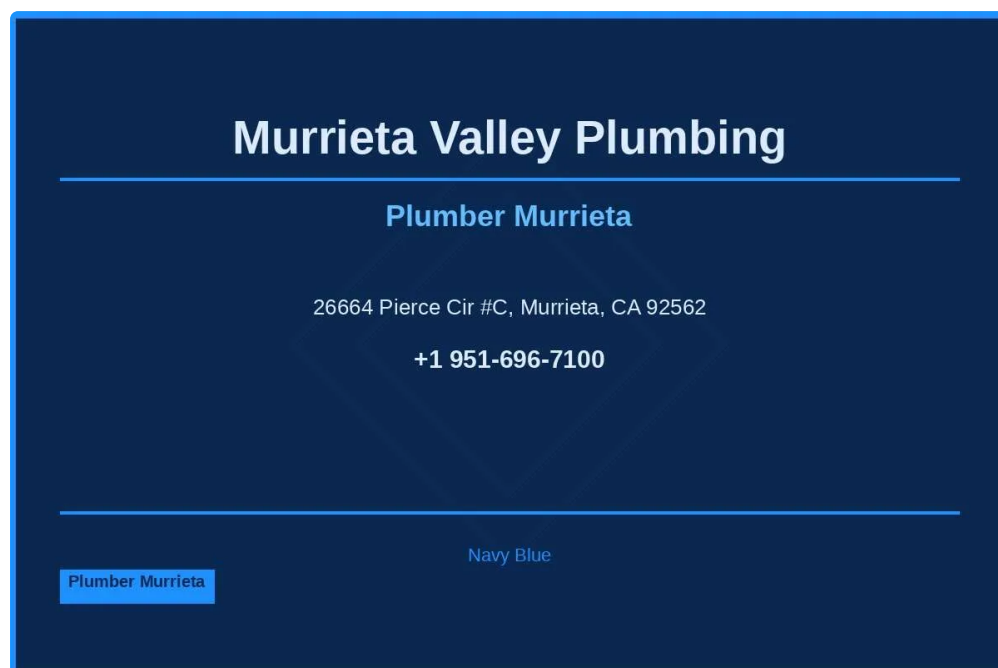


Garbage Disposal Repair and Replacement in Murrieta A jammed or dead garbage disposal is one of the smaller plumbing headaches, but it is also one of the most immediately noticeable, especially mid meal prep when the sink suddenly backs up. Most disposal problems fall into one of a few categories, a jam from something that should not have gone down the drain, a burned out motor after years of use, or a leak at the connection where the unit meets the sink drain. Running cold water during and after use, avoiding fibrous foods and grease, and resetting the unit from underneath before assuming the worst are all simple habits that extend a disposal's working life considerably. That said, disposals do not last forever, and a unit that has been in place for eight to ten years is often better replaced than repaired again, especially once the motor itself starts to sound strained rather than just jammed. Murrieta Valley Plumbing stocks a range of disposal horsepower options and can usually complete a full swap in under an hour, getting a kitchen back to normal the same day the call comes in.
