Old, flaking film receives scraped to a organization area, then sanded to feather the transition. For bare wood, I sand to 80 or a hundred grit on floors, rather finer, 120 to 150, on railings wherein palms really feel every little

thing. I all the time countersink popped fasteners and change corroded screws for stainless or coated structural screws. On patios, I degrease with a citrus solvent in which grills have dripped, then use a drive wash at protected distance. Pitted concrete repeatedly desires an etch or a mechanical grind for proper adhesion. No sealer bonds long-term to concrete dirt or algae.
