The backsplash ran complete peak, stores moved to the bottom of the upper shelves, and the island had no overhang at the window area, so it examine like a monolith rather than a bar. A family members house with three university-age teenagers and a extreme prepare dinner crucial durability in particular. Perimeter counters went to leathered black granite. We planned seam placement after templating, aligning the faint quartzite veins with the cupboard rails. Three years later, the surfaces nevertheless glance fresh, and the occasional nick on the granite side buffs out with a diamond pad.
