

Let me begin with an unpleasant truth. Fireworks are beautiful . But they are also dangerous . One small error can cause injuries, fires, or worse .

I've been in event management for over a decade , and I've seen fireworks done right . I've also seen them done terribly wrong . The distinction is nearly always in the planning.

That's exactly why I developed this guide. If you're hiring an event agency to handle fireworks , here's what you absolutely need to confirm. Whether you work with Kollysphere or another provider , these are non-negotiable .

Why “We Know a Guy” Is Not Acceptable

Here's the most important question . “Does your agency hold a valid pyrotechnics license from the Malaysian Fire and Rescue Department ?”

In Malaysia , fireworks are regulated by the Fire Services Act 1988 . Only licensed operators can purchase, transport, and fire fireworks . The penalty for unlicensed fireworks can include fines up to RM50,000 and jail time .

Request to view the permit. Take a photo of it . Confirm the expiration date. If the agency hesitates or makes excuses , leave immediately.

Your planner should also manage all local permits from the city council (DBKL for KL, MBPJ for PJ, and so on). This includes police notification and crowd safety approval .

With us, we keep our license displayed in our office and on our website . We file all permits at least 30 days before any fireworks event . If we cannot obtain the approvals, we inform the customer right away. We do not proceed illegally .



Insurance Coverage: What Happens If Something Goes Wrong

Basic gathering coverage does not include pyrotechnics. Fireworks require specialised pyrotechnics insurance .

Ask your agency : “Do you have specific pyrotechnics liability insurance ?” What is the policy limit?”



A skilled pyrotechnics display should carry no less than five million ringgit in protection. For significant gatherings (more than one thousand attendees), ten million ringgit or higher is typical.

Ask for the insurance certificate . Verify that it explicitly references “pyrotechnics” or “fireworks”. General liability is not enough .

Also ask : Are your subcontracted teams (if applicable) also covered?” Some agencies hire freelance fireworks crews . If those freelancers aren’t insured , you could be responsible for their errors.

At Kollysphere events , we carry RM10 million in pyrotechnics-specific coverage . We do not outsource pyrotechnics. Our licensed team fires every show .

Safety Distances and Exclusion Zones

Fireworks explode . Burning fragments fall . Attendees need sufficient distance.

Request from your planner: What is your required exclusion zone for these pyrotechnic types?”

Industry guidelines suggest:

For small fireworks (up to 75mm shells) : 100 metres from the launch site . For moderate pyrotechnics (three to six inches): 200 metres . For substantial pyrotechnics (six to twelve inches): 300 metres or more .

The planner should supply a diagram indicating the safety perimeter. This map should be shared with the venue, security team, and local police .

What about descending materials? Request: “What is your plan for post-show debris removal ?” A professional agency will clear the firing zone following the performance. They will gather unexploded items and paper cylinders. They will not abandon dangerous materials.

I once attended an event where the agency didn’t clean up . Youngsters discovered unfired pyrotechnics the following day. Fortunately, no one was injured. But that agency was banned from every venue in Selangor .

The Go/No-Go Decision Process

Malaysia’s climate is uncertain. Clear skies early evening. Thunderstorm at 7:30 PM .

Ask your agency : “What wind speed cancels the show ?” Professional guidelines say 30 km/h for small fireworks, 20 km/h for large shells .

“What about rain ?” Light rain might be acceptable . Intense storms and electrical activity are complete stoppages.

“Who makes the call ?” The response should be: “Our pyrotechnics manager, in consultation with the venue and client .” It should not be: “We’ll let you decide.” You are not a fireworks expert . You should not determine safety-critical choices.

What is the backup plan ? If conditions stop the display, do you receive your money back? Does the planner rearrange without additional fees? Get this in writing .

At Kollysphere , we maintain an explicit documented climate procedure. If we cancel for safety reasons , we rearrange without extra cost. If the client [Kollysphere Events](#) cancels for non-safety reasons (we don’t recommend this) , deposits may be forfeited .

Why “Our Guy Has Done This Before” Is Not Enough

The permit belongs to the agency. But the actual individual activating the system needs their own qualifications .

Request: Who is the primary fireworks operator for our gathering?” What qualification do they possess?”

Locally, certification from the Fire and Rescue Department’s Pyrotechnics Course is the minimum standard . Additional credentials from international bodies (like the BPA or the APA) suggest greater skill.

Request information about history. How many displays has this technician executed?” “Have they ever had an accident ?” A skilled operator will respond truthfully.

With us, our lead pyrotechnician has 15 years of experience . They have fired over 500 shows . They have zero accident record . They recertify annually .

Fire Marshal and Emergency Services Coordination

This is what many customers don’t realise. Your event agency should notify the local fire department regarding your pyrotechnic show. This is not optional . This is legally required.

Ask : Have you informed the nearby fire department?” “What was their response ?”

A skilled planner will supply the name of the fire officer they spoke with . The day and hour of the discussion. The reference number if applicable .

Why does this matter ? Because if an attendee dials emergency services to report “blaze at the gathering”, the fire department needs to know that it’s a planned fireworks display . Otherwise, they might dispatch multiple emergency vehicles. Otherwise, they might disrupt your gathering.

With us, we submit an official notice to the nearby fire department two weeks prior to any pyrotechnic display. We obtain a signed confirmation. We keep this document with our permits .

Five Clauses Every Fireworks Contract Needs

Fireworks are too dangerous for handshake deals . All details require documentation.

Here are the five clauses that must be in your fireworks contract :

Precise position of the firing area (indicated on a diagram). Safety perimeter measurements and enforcement methods. Climate stoppage rules and payment/date-change conditions. Evidence of coverage (document appended to the agreement). Post-show cleanup responsibility (who clears debris and when) .

If any of these are missing , do not agree. Request a revised agreement. If the agency refuses , locate another provider.

At Kollysphere events , our pyrotechnics agreement spans multiple pages. It is thorough and precise. Clients sometimes joke that it's longer than their wedding vows . But no one has ever had a misunderstanding on event day .

The Cost of Cutting Corners

Let me be blunt . If an agency quotes you RM5,000 for a fireworks show when others are charging fifteen thousand, something is wrong .

Maybe they're skipping insurance . Perhaps they're employing unlicensed technicians. Maybe they're ignoring safety distances . Maybe they're avoiding permits .

Every corner cut increases risk to your guests . A serious fireworks accident can result in millions in legal claims. Can ruin your reputation permanently . Can injure the people you invited to celebrate .
