4. Make Use Of "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the lowest total worth wins) turns standard logic on its head. While it can be fun, it relies completely on hitting inexpensive, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with basic case-opening reasoning.
