

Garage door repair cost in Los Angeles varies with the malfunctioning component, the type and age of the door, access conditions, and whether you need regular or after-hours service. A basic adjustment may involve a modest service call and labor charge, while a broken torsion spring, damaged garage door panel, failed garage door opener, or door off track can require replacement parts and extra work.
