What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live gambling establishment video game built around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The video game is hosted by a live, energetic speaker who spins the wheel, interacts with the audience by means of live chat, and guides gamers through the various segments.

What sets Crazy Time apart from basic wheel video games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a leading slot placed straight above the primary wheel. With every spin, the top slot **play crazy time demo** spins at the same time, generating a random multiplier for a particular bet area. If the wheel stops on that spot and a bonus offer or number is increased, players can win astronomical payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 segments on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay out basic prize money) and reward rounds (which trigger minigames). Understanding the circulation of these segments is important for handling bankrolls and understanding the game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can put bets on 4 different numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number corresponds to its payment multiplier if the wheel lands on it.



- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (greatest frequency, most affordable payment of 1:1).

- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payout of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payout of 5:1).
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payout of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The real excitement of Crazy Time lies in its 4 bonus rounds. These inhabit a combined overall of 9 sections on the wheel, making them rarer to hit, however greatly more rewarding.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 sectors on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sectors on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 sectors on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 segment on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a benefit sector, all players who placed a bet on that specific benefit round are carried to a separate, immersive set (or increased reality screen) to get involved.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the benefit rounds, Coin Flip involves a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is assigned a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to flip the coin, and whichever side lands deal with up awards the player that matching multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be set off for a 2nd chance.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the conventional Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko bonus round features an enormous wall filled with physical pegs. The game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces randomly down through the pegs up until it lands in among the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive on a **"Double"** worth, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped again for even greater stakes.

3. Cash Hunt

Cash Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers are presented with an enormous screen showing 108 random multipliers hidden behind various signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Gamers utilize an on-screen crosshair to goal and "shoot" their picked symbol before the timer runs out.
- When time expires, all symbols reveal their concealed multipliers, and players get the multiplier connected to their chosen target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the game is the Crazy Time bonus offer round. Gamers walk through a red door into a lively, virtual wonderland featuring an enormous, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, players should pick among 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow.**
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is granted to the gamer.

- Similar to Pachinko, this wheel includes "**Double**" and "**Triple**" sectors. If the flapper arrive at one of these, the multipliers on the wheel boost, and the wheel is spun again-- possibly pressing payments up to the video game's maximum limitation of **20,000 x**.

Secret Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is fundamentally a game of chance powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, players often adopt specific wagering methods to handle their danger and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on banking on numbers 1 and 2, while placing little hedge bets on bonus offer rounds. This approach yields regular, smaller wins and keeps the bankroll steady.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets exclusively on the 4 bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility strategy created for gamers who wish to experience the minigames as typically as possible, accepting that they might experience droughts of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all 4 perk rounds proportionally. This guarantees that practically every spin of the wheel yields some kind of return or sets off a function.

Vital Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed bankroll before visiting and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that different bets have a little different Return to Player percentages. Number bets typically offer a higher analytical RTP than bonus bets, however bonus bets use the excitement of enormous multipliers.
- **Take pleasure in the Show:** Crazy Time is developed as home entertainment initially. Treat the prospective jackpots as a reward to the interactive, game-show experience.
