What to stage, and what no longer to

Stage heavy and cumbersome first: platforms, kiosks, fencing, and damaged leases. Flatten cardboard and package deal it with tape so it stacks tight and fast. Keep electronics and batteries out of the general pile. Label bags that contain damaged glass or sharp particles so crews can glove up and cargo them ultimate.
