If you like clarity, managed processes, and a training plan you can follow up defined turning points, an Approved Training Company with an online course-management portal is most likely to really feel comfortable. If you like to recognize where you stand, portal-based progress monitoring typically decreases uncertainty.

If you dislike organized routines, you may discover the air travel training rhythm demanding.
