Players place bets on numbers (1, 2, 5, or 10) or on among the four distinct bonus offer rounds. If the wheel stops on the sector a player has wagered on, they win a payment or gain entry into an immersive mini-game.

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Understanding the Betting Layout

Before the wheel spins, gamers have a limited window to position their chips on the betting grid. The grid includes eight distinct wagering options, split uniformly between basic numbers and bonus triggers.

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payment: 1:1.
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1.
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payment: 5:1.
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payment: 10:1.
- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Activates the Coin Flip reward.
- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Activates the Cash Hunt perk.

- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Activates the Pachinko benefit.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel. Sets off the supreme reward round.

The Top Slot Feature: Amplifying the Action

Adding a layer of standard slot mechanics to the video game, every single spin of the main wheel is accompanied by a **Top Slot** situated directly above the speaker and the wheel.

The Top Slot includes two reels that spin concurrently:

1. **Reel 1:** Displays a betting area (a number or a bonus round).
2. **Reel 2:** Displays a multiplier value (varying from 2x approximately 50x).

If the horizontal line in the Top Slot connects a betting spot with a multiplier, that multiplier is applied to the outcome of the main wheel spin, supplied the wheel arrive on that specific spot. If a benefit round is increased, all rewards inside that bonus offer round are increased appropriately, causing the game's famous huge payments.

Deep Dive: The Four Bonus Rounds

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade video game, a glowing puck is dropped from the top of a huge wall filled with pegs.
- **Payment:** The puck bounces down the board up until it lands in a multiplier slot at the bottom. If it hits a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 section on the wheel.

- **Mechanic:** Players travel through a red door into a virtual, psychedelic world featuring an enormous giant wheel.
- **Payment:** Players choose among three flippers (green, blue, or yellow). The presenter presses a huge red button to spin the giant wheel. It can yield multipliers approximately 20,000 x if "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" segments are hit along the method.

Strategies for Playing the Crazy Time Slot

While Crazy Time is essentially a game of chance governed by a random number generator (RNG) and physical wheel physics, players frequently use various bankroll management techniques.

- **The Balanced Spread:** Spacing bets throughout both numbers and benefit rounds to guarantee that regular small wins from numbers can assist money the pursuit of bonus offer features.

- **Treat it as Entertainment:** View your house edge and wagers as the cost of admission for an interactive entertainment program instead of a trustworthy source of income.
- **Take Breaks:** Step away from the screen periodically to keep a clear head.
