The Los Angeles City Rail system links locations across the region, consisting of Long Coastline, Pasadena, Norwalk, El Segundo, North Hollywood, Inglewood and Midtown Los Angeles. The network consists of 4 above-ground light rail lines (the A, C, E, and K lines) and one underground subway with two branches (the B and D lines). Between its public transportation and hefty rail systems, Metro Rail has 107.4 miles (172.8 km) of rail, averaging 308,653 journeys per weekday, and accountancy for around 1.1% of the 29 million daily trips coming from Los Angeles County. The J Line runs 38 miles (61 kilometres) along Interstate 10 and Interstate 110 in between El Monte and midtown San Pedro. Including other municipal bus operators, Los Angeles County averages 1.7 million bus boardings per weekday, making up approximately 5.9% of the 29 million daily trips coming from Los Angeles County.
