

Serving the Wider Glendale Metro Area

While Aghbashian Dental Corp is based in Glendale's Verdugo Viejo district, the practice's patient base extends well beyond the immediate neighborhood, drawing from across a wider swath of the northern Los Angeles metro area that includes Burbank, Pasadena, La Canada Flintridge, and several other surrounding communities. This wider draw reflects Glendale's position as a genuinely significant commercial and residential hub within Los Angeles County, well connected by the 134 Freeway to neighboring cities and offering the kind of comprehensive, in-house dental scope, from routine cleanings through implants and oral surgery, that smaller surrounding communities do not always have locally in the same depth. Patients from these neighboring areas often first discover Aghbashian Dental Corp through word of mouth, a coworker, a family member, or a neighbor who made the trip into Glendale and found the experience worthwhile enough to recommend to others back in their own community. This kind of organic, cross-city referral network has built up gradually over the years the practice has been operating. The relatively central position of Glendale within this wider metro area means the drive time from most surrounding communities remains genuinely manageable, rarely more than twenty or thirty minutes even [Dentist Glendale CA](#) from communities like La Canada Flintridge, which sit at the outer edge of the practice's typical patient draw. Whether a patient lives in Glendale itself or is traveling in from a neighboring community, Aghbashian Dental Corp aims to offer the same consistent, transparent standard of care regardless of how far a patient happens to be traveling for their appointment. This wider geographic draw also means the practice has developed real familiarity with insurance networks and plan types common across several neighboring cities, not just Glendale itself, a practical benefit for patients whose coverage may have been issued through an employer based in a different part of the greater Los Angeles area. Staying connected to this broader regional patient base has also given Dr. Aghbashian's team a wider perspective on the varying dental needs and preferences across different communities in the area. This breadth of experience continues to inform how the practice approaches care for every new patient walking through the door, regardless of which city they call home. Costs vary widely depending on the treatment involved and the practice you choose. Aghbashian Dental Corp presents fee-for-service pricing transparently before any treatment begins, so patients paying out of pocket know exactly what to expect. CareCredit financing and in-house payment plans are also available to help spread larger costs into manageable payments. Do any dental plans cover preventive care at 100 percent? Many dental plans do cover routine exams, cleanings and standard X-rays in full when you stay in network, though coverage details vary by plan. Aghbashian Dental Corp works with Medi-Cal, Denti-Cal and a range of PPO plans, and the front desk team is happy to help verify what a specific plan actually covers before an appointment. Is a root canal cheaper than a crown? A root canal on its own is typically less expensive than a crown, though the two are often needed together, since a tooth that has had a root canal usually requires a crown afterward to restore its strength. Dr. Nova Aghbashian's team at Aghbashian Dental Corp walks patients through the full cost of both steps upfront rather than presenting them as separate surprises. Why can a root canal cost as much as 3000 dollars? A bill in that range usually reflects both the root canal procedure itself and the permanent crown placed afterward, not the root canal alone. Aghbashian Dental Corp breaks this down clearly during treatment planning, and CareCredit or in-house financing can help spread the combined cost into more manageable monthly payments. Will a dentist pull a severely decayed tooth? Yes, extraction becomes necessary when a tooth is too damaged by decay to be saved with a filling, crown or root canal. Dr. Nova Aghbashian evaluates each case individually at Aghbashian Dental Corp, always looking first at whether the tooth can realistically be saved before recommending extraction

as a last resort. Can a tooth still decay under a crown? Yes, a crown protects the visible part of a tooth but the natural tooth structure underneath, along with the gum line around it, can still decay if not cleaned properly. Aghbashian Dental Corp checks existing crowns during routine exams specifically to catch this kind of hidden decay before it becomes a bigger problem. What hurts worse, a tooth extraction or a root canal? Most patients report that the extraction site is sorer during recovery than a root canal, since a root canal is specifically designed to relieve the pressure and infection causing pain in the first place. Both procedures are performed under local anesthesia at Aghbashian Dental Corp, and Dr. Aghbashian walks every patient through exactly what to expect beforehand. What is considered the most painful dental procedure? Public perception often points to root canals, though many patients and dentists actually consider impacted wisdom teeth removal more physically demanding during recovery. Aghbashian Dental Corp offers sedation options for more involved procedures, and Dr. Nova Aghbashian's team focuses on managing discomfort proactively rather than leaving patients to simply push through it. What destroys teeth the most? Frequent sugar intake combined with acid exposure is the leading cause of tooth decay, since this combination feeds the bacteria that erode enamel over time. Aghbashian Dental Corp's routine cleanings and exams are designed to catch this kind of gradual damage early, before it progresses into a cavity or something more serious. What drinks damage teeth the most? Energy drinks and sodas, including diet varieties, tend to cause the most damage, since they combine high acid content with sugar or artificial sweeteners that keep bacteria active on the tooth surface. Patients at Aghbashian Dental Corp are given practical, judgment free guidance on reducing this kind of damage during routine visits. What strengthens tooth enamel the most? Fluoride remains the most effective way to strengthen enamel, binding to its mineral structure and helping reverse the earliest stages of decay before a cavity actually forms. Aghbashian Dental Corp's cleanings include this kind of preventive care as standard, part of why routine visits matter even when nothing feels obviously wrong. Which teeth are hardest for a dentist to remove? Impacted wisdom teeth and molars with curved or multiple roots tend to be the most challenging to extract, often requiring more time and sometimes a surgical approach. Dr. Nova Aghbashian's training in oral surgery means Aghbashian Dental Corp handles these more complex extractions in house at the Glendale office, without referring patients elsewhere.
