4. Coinflip

A classic 1v1 game of chance. Two players wager skins of approximately equal value. The system designates one gamer as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the whole pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to alternative. Users bet on expert groups utilizing odds determined by the platform, comparable to conventional sportsbooks.
