Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

- **Blackjack Payouts:** Always look for tables that pay **3:2** for a natural blackjack. Avoid tables that pay **6:5**, as this substantially increases the house benefit.
- **Dealer Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealership must hit or stand on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealership standing on soft 17 is more beneficial to the player.
