4. Coinflip

A timeless 1v1 game of opportunity. Two players wager skins of approximately equivalent worth. The system designates one gamer as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the professional scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to option. Users bet on expert groups utilizing odds determined by the platform, comparable to standard sportsbooks.
