What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live gambling establishment game built around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The game is hosted by a live, energetic presenter who spins the wheel, communicates with the audience by means of live chat, and guides gamers through the different sections.

What sets Crazy Time apart from standard wheel video games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a top slot placed [bitz.io](#) straight above the main wheel. With every spin, the top slot spins all at once, creating a random multiplier for a particular bet spot. If the wheel stops on that spot and a bonus or number is increased, gamers can win astronomical payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sections on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay basic prize money) and reward rounds (which set off minigames). Understanding the circulation of these sections is essential for managing bankrolls and understanding the game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can put bets on 4 different numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number represents its payment multiplier if the wheel arrive on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (greatest frequency, least expensive payout of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payment of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payment of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The true excitement of Crazy Time lies in its four benefit rounds. These inhabit a combined overall of 9 segments on the wheel, making them rarer to hit, but vastly more fulfilling.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 sectors on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sections on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 sections on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 section on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a perk sector, all players who put a bet on that specific perk round are transferred to a separate, immersive set (or enhanced truth screen) to get involved.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the bonus offer rounds, Coin Flip includes a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is appointed a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to turn the coin, and whichever side lands deal with up awards the gamer that corresponding multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be triggered for a 2nd possibility.

2. Pachinko

Inspired by the traditional Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko perk round features a massive wall filled with physical pegs. The game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs till it lands in one of the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive on a **"Double"** value, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped again for even higher stakes.

3. Money Hunt

Cash Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers exist with a massive screen displaying 108 random multipliers concealed behind various signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Gamers use an on-screen crosshair to aim and "shoot" their chosen symbol before the timer runs out.
- When time expires, all signs expose their hidden multipliers, and players receive the multiplier connected to their chosen target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the game is the Crazy Time bonus offer round. Players walk through a red door into a vibrant, virtual wonderland including an enormous, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, gamers must choose among three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is awarded to the gamer.
- Similar to Pachinko, this wheel features **"Double"** and **"Triple"** segments. If the flapper arrive on one of these, the multipliers on the wheel boost, and the wheel is spun once again-- possibly pushing payouts up to the game's optimum limit of **20,000 x**.

Secret Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is essentially a video game of possibility powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, gamers frequently embrace particular betting strategies to manage their danger and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on banking on numbers 1 and 2, while putting little hedge bets on perk rounds. This technique yields regular, smaller sized wins and keeps the bankroll steady.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets specifically on the 4 bonus offer rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility technique designed for players who desire to experience the minigames as often as possible, accepting that they may experience droughts of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all four benefit rounds proportionally. This makes sure that practically every spin of the wheel yields some form of return or activates a feature.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed bankroll before visiting and never chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that different bets have slightly different Return to Player percentages. Number bets typically offer a greater statistical RTP than benefit bets, however bonus bets offer the enjoyment of massive multipliers.
- **Enjoy the Show:** Crazy Time is designed as home entertainment first. Treat the prospective profits as a reward to the interactive, game-show experience.
