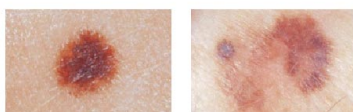

## ASYMMETRY



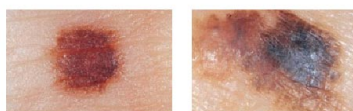
A spot that's irregular, instead of being round

## BORDER



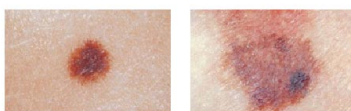
An uneven border, or a ragged edge

## COLOR



Uneven color, with different shades of black and brown

## DIAMETER



Larger than a pencil eraser

## EVOLVING



Changes in size, color, or thickness

**Other forms of skin cancer can also take different appearances:**

A red, scaly patch (large or small) that won't clear up or keeps coming back

A skin-colored bump that grows slowly

A sore that won't heal

A "growing scar" – a firm, recessed spot, either skin-colored or lighter

Melanomas and non-melanoma cancers can be either raised or flat.
