Problems arise while circulation is blocked: fasteners that are too tight, stiff caulk joints, or appliances set challenging against cabinet aspects with out growth hole.

Temperature subjects too. Avoid venting a coffee maker's steam right now into the underside of an top cupboard. Pull it forward while brewing so vapor clears the face.
