On a church campus simply north of Olde Towne, we faced broadleaf breakouts both fall. After troubleshooting, we found overdue-summer season irrigation working nightly, shallow and short. That kept the right inch rainy and invited weeds. We switched to deeper cycles with longer rest durations, brought a September fertilizer with 50 % gradual liberate, and constrained put up-emergent to spot paintings. Within one season, dandelion counts dropped by means of part with none bring up in herbicide.

A multifamily advanced close Aspen Creek colleges had site visitors-worn paths among parking and entrances. Pre-emergent did its job, but seed couldn't set up after citizens cut corners. We outfitted small paver paths wherein foot traffic sought after to go, aerated adjoining turf, and seeded tall fescue in overdue August.
