

A faulty garage door can impact safety, parking, daily routines, and entry into your home. Whether a garage door won't open, the opener makes unexpected sounds, or a broken garage door spring leaves the door immobile, the best remedy is determined by the failed component and the door's current condition. What are the most common garage door problems?
