## How to Acquire Rare Cases

Acquiring these products can be done through a number of channels:

- **In-Game Drops**-- Participate in the original operation or event where the case was readily available. Some cases still drop occasionally during "replay" objectives, though the possibility stays tiny.
- **Markets**-- Platforms such as the Steam Community Market, Buff.163, or third-party skin sites (e.g., CSGOStash) list uncommon cases. Constantly verify the seller's track record and use escrow services.
- **Trade-Ups**-- Combining less important skins in a "trade-up" contract can, on uncommon occasions, yield a case from the desired swimming pool, but the odds are low.
- **\*\* giveaways & Contests \*\***-- Occasionally, developers or esports companies host giveaways throughout major tournaments or anniversaries.
