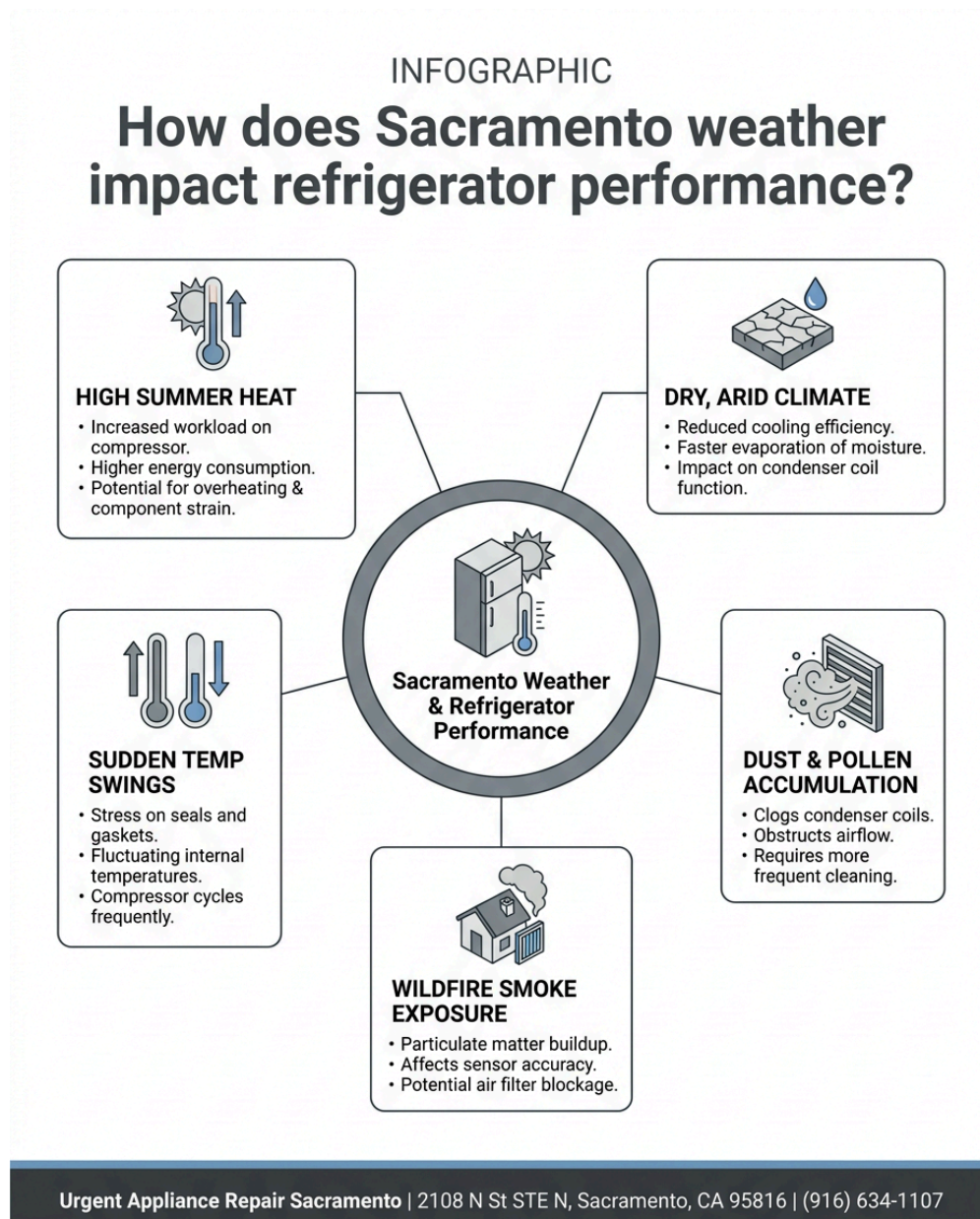


Most washers operate reliably for 10 to 14 years, while dryers typically last 10 to 13 years under normal use. When Replacement Shock Arrives Without Preventive Repair Planning

Many homeowners operate washers and dryers into their 16th, 17th, or even 18th year by deferring repairs. They convince themselves the appliance still works, so why replace it? A refrigerant-based seal in an older dryer becomes brittle; a pump impeller in an aging washer cracks under pressure; a thermal cut-off fails to reset.
