Core Strategies for Winning CS2 Battles

1. **Utility Stacking**-- With dynamic smoke, teams integrate flashbangs and Molotovs to produce "smoke-holes" that give vision while blocking opponent lines of sight.
2. **Map Control Early**-- Securing essential choke points (e.g., mid doors on Mirage) before the opponent can establish defaults forces them into unfavorable retakes.

5. **Post-Plant Positioning**-- With smoke responding to bullets, defenders can now block sightlines after planting the bomb, turning a basic hold into a vibrant battle of geometry.
