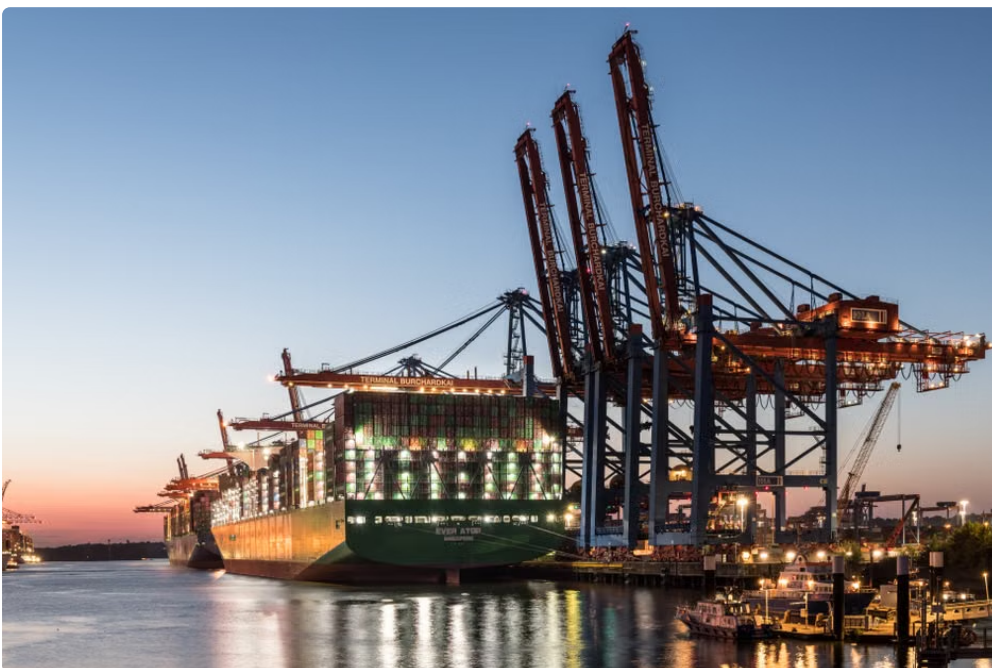

- **Pricing:** Starts near €90 per month, with transparent prompt usage limits and tiered monitoring options.
- **Integration:** Built to fit existing marketing workflows, supporting multiple SEO tools via API connectors.

AthenaHQ

- **Focus:** AI-assisted content planning, prompt tracking, and automated reporting dashboards.
- **Pricing:** Quoted prices are contact sales only but generally target medium to large agencies, indicating starter prices above €100/mo.

- **Features:** Daily prompt monitoring, version histories, and alerting on keywords and brand IP infringements.

Pricing Transparency, Prompt Limits and Add-Ons: What to Watch For

- **ChatGPT:** Known for high-quality context and fine-tuned responses, but token usage is billed per prompt, adding to monthly fees.
- **Perplexity:** Offers fast and affordable API access but may provide less nuanced insight, impacting content optimization quality.

When a tool like Peec AI does not disclose its engine composition at starter prices, users may be unknowingly paying for limited engines or be required to purchase add-ons for premium AI models.
