That approach addresses the symptom—visible moisture—but not the root problem. Dehumidifiers work by pulling air through a cold coil, condensing moisture, and collecting it in a tank. A consumer dehumidifier rated for 50 pints per day removes that moisture only from the air passing through it. In a 2,000-square-foot home

with water in walls, subflooring, and cavities, a single dehumidifier simply cannot process enough air quickly enough.



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Box fans move air horizontally across wet surfaces but do little to accelerate evaporation deep inside materials. Professional equipment combines aggressive air movement with continuous dehumidification in a coordinated strategy.
