Comparing several providers gives you an opportunity to identify differences before making a commitment. You can determine which companies have experience with your type of move, which services they provide, how their estimates are structured, and how previous customers describe their experiences.

The goal should not simply be to find the cheapest mover. Instead, look for a company that provides an appropriate combination of reliability, service, professionalism, transparency, and affordability.

Determine What Kind of Move You Are Planning

Before requesting estimates, define your relocation requirements. The type of move you are planning can influence which companies are appropriate and how much the move may cost.

Local Residential Moving

Local moves may involve relocating within Farmington or to a nearby community. These moves can include apartments, condominiums, townhouses, and single-family homes.

Even when the distance is short, factors such as stairs, elevators, parking, furniture size, and the number of belongings can affect the moving process.

Long-Distance Moving

Long-distance moves require additional transportation planning and coordination. If you are relocating to another state, ask whether the company regularly handles interstate moves and how it manages pickup and delivery schedules.

Apartment and Condo Moving

Full-service moving may include packing, loading, transportation, unloading, furniture placement, and other assistance. This can be useful for customers who have limited time or a large household.

Make a List of the Services You Need

Before comparing prices, identify the services that are important for your relocation. Potential services can include:

- Local residential moving
- Long-distance moving
- Apartment moving
- Packing and unpacking
- Loading and unloading
- Furniture disassembly and reassembly
- Furniture protection
- Temporary storage
- Specialty item handling

Once you know what you need, you can compare companies based on the same requirements rather than comparing unrelated service packages.

Research the Best Farmington Movers

One estimate may include furniture wrapping, packing materials, disassembly, and reassembly, while another may charge separately for these services. A more expensive quote may therefore represent a more comprehensive service.

What Factors Influence Moving Prices?

Moving costs can vary depending on several factors. Understanding these variables can help you evaluate estimates more effectively.

Size of the Shipment

The number and size of your belongings can affect the amount of labor and transportation space required. Larger homes generally require more resources than small apartments.

Distance

The distance between your current and new property can influence transportation time and overall moving expenses.

Labor

The number of movers required and the time needed to complete loading and unloading can affect the total price.

Access

Stairs, elevators, narrow hallways, long distances from parking areas, and other difficult access conditions may increase the time required to complete the move.

Packing

Professional packing services can make preparation easier but may increase the overall cost. Ask whether packing materials and labor are included.

Storage

If there is a gap between your move-out and move-in dates, temporary storage may be necessary. Ask whether the moving company offers storage solutions and how they are priced.

Price should be considered carefully, but choosing the lowest estimate automatically can be risky. A low quote may not include all the services you need or may be based on incomplete information.

Instead, compare the overall value of each moving company. Consider the service package, experience, communication, customer reviews, equipment, scheduling, and pricing transparency.

A dependable company that provides clear terms and professional support may be a better choice than a company offering a lower but less comprehensive estimate.

Evaluate Moving Company Experience

Experience is an important factor when selecting professional movers. Ask how long the company has been providing moving services and what types of moves it handles regularly.

Relevant experience can be particularly valuable when a move has special circumstances. Large furniture, fragile belongings, difficult building access, and long-distance transportation can all require additional preparation.

A company that regularly handles similar relocations may be more familiar with the planning and equipment required for the job.

Consider Local Moving Knowledge

- Billing practices

- Problem resolution
- Overall customer satisfaction

Consistent feedback can help you identify the strengths and weaknesses of a moving company.

Look at How the Company Handles Complaints

Even professional companies can encounter occasional problems. What matters is how those problems are handled.

When reviewing customer feedback, look for evidence that the company responds professionally to concerns. A business that communicates clearly and works to resolve legitimate issues may demonstrate stronger customer support than one that ignores complaints.

Evaluate Communication Before Hiring

Your interactions with a moving company before the move can tell you a lot about its communication style.

Ask questions about pricing, scheduling, packing, access requirements, and protection procedures. Notice whether the company provides clear answers and whether representatives are easy to reach.

Good communication becomes even more important when a move involves unusual circumstances or a tight schedule.

Ask About Furniture Protection

Furniture can be vulnerable to scratches, dents, and other damage during transportation. Ask potential movers how they protect furniture during loading, transportation, and unloading.

Professional crews may use moving blankets, protective wrapping, padding, straps, dollies, and other equipment depending on the type of furniture and property.

If you have antiques, artwork, glass furniture, oversized pieces, or other delicate items, discuss their handling requirements before the move.

Understand Valuation and Protection Options

Before hiring a moving company, ask about its policies regarding responsibility for belongings during transportation. Different moves may have different applicable protection and valuation arrangements.

Read your moving agreement carefully and ask questions about terms that are unclear. Understanding these details before moving day can help you make a more informed decision.

Check the Moving Equipment

Ask About Packing Services

If you choose professional packing, ask what materials are included and whether the movers will pack the entire household or only selected rooms or items.

If you prefer to pack yourself, start early and use sturdy boxes, adequate cushioning, and clear labels.

Develop a Moving Inventory

An inventory helps you understand exactly what will be transported. List major furniture, appliances, electronics, fragile items, and other important belongings.

Creating an inventory also gives you an opportunity to declutter. Consider donating, selling, recycling, or disposing of items that you no longer use.

Reducing unnecessary belongings can make packing easier and potentially reduce the amount of labor and transportation space required.

Prepare for Apartment and Property Restrictions

If you are moving into or out of an apartment, condominium, or managed property, contact the building management team before moving day.

Ask about elevator reservations, moving hours, loading zones, parking restrictions, security procedures, and any required documentation.

Share these details with your moving company so the crew can plan appropriately.

Compare Customer Support

Customer support is an important but sometimes overlooked factor when comparing movers. Ask who your primary contact will be and how you can reach the company before and during the relocation.

Consider whether the company explains its processes clearly and provides useful updates when appropriate.

Look for consistency between customer feedback and the services described by the company. If a mover emphasizes careful handling and professional service, reviews should provide some evidence that customers have experienced those qualities.

Prepare for Moving Day

Once you have selected a moving company, preparation should continue until moving day.

Complete your packing responsibilities according to the agreed schedule. Label boxes clearly and keep essential items separate.

Clear pathways and make sure movers can access furniture and boxes. Keep children and pets away from active loading areas for safety.

Before leaving your old property, check closets, cabinets, storage spaces, garages, and other areas to make sure nothing has been forgotten.

Keep an Essentials Bag With You

An essentials bag can make the transition easier. Keep important documents, medications, chargers, basic toiletries, clothing, valuables, and other necessities accessible.

If your move is long-distance, keep these items with you rather than placing them in the main shipment. You may need them before the moving truck arrives at your new home.

Inspect Belongings After Delivery

Once the movers arrive at your destination, compare your belongings with your inventory. Check major furniture, appliances, electronics, boxes, and other important possessions.

If you notice any issue, document it and follow the procedures outlined in your moving agreement. Keep relevant paperwork and communications organized.

Common Mistakes to Avoid When Hiring Movers

Choosing Only Based on Price

Failing to Research Experience

A mover with limited experience in your type of relocation may not be the best fit for a complex move.
