In Philadelphia, I have seen more flooded basements at 2 a.m. Than at any affordable hour of the workday. Old real estate stock, narrow rowhomes, shared sewer lines, and winter temperature level swings all make pipes here a bit more unforgiving than in numerous other cities.

When water is pouring from a ceiling or a sewer line is supporting into a completed basement, you are not shopping gradually for a professional. You are attempting to stop damage and get somebody qualified to your door as fast as possible, without agreeing blindly to anything.
