

South Georgia Climate RV Mechanical Effects Heat Humidity I-75 Bennett South Georgia's climate is not mentioned often enough in discussions of RV maintenance and mechanical reliability. The combination of extreme summer heat, persistently high humidity, and the sustained thermal cycling that comes from hours of interstate driving in these conditions creates a mechanical environment that is significantly more demanding than the cooler, drier climates that many RV travelers come from or are heading to. Understanding how South Georgia's climate affects RV mechanical systems helps travelers manage the specific risks that driving through Valdosta in summer creates. Rubber components bear the brunt of the heat and humidity combination. Radiator hoses, coolant bypass hoses, serpentine belts, and other rubber components all degrade faster in South Georgia's conditions than manufacturer life estimates based on temperate climate testing would suggest. A serpentine belt that might last another season in Ohio or North Carolina may split under the stress of a July drive through Lowndes County. Bennett Mobile Truck Repair's service history along I-75 reflects how consistently these rubber component failures occur during summer months, and the service truck is stocked with common hoses and belts specifically because of that pattern. Battery performance is also significantly affected by heat. High ambient temperatures accelerate the chemical degradation of lead-acid battery cells, reducing capacity and [Mobile RV Repair](#) increasing the likelihood of failure. The battery that cranked well in northern spring conditions may not have enough capacity to start the engine reliably after a hot Georgia summer night at a campground. This is a particularly common pattern for travelers heading north from Florida in late spring and early summer.
