Polished granites and marbles have top specular reflectance. Think of a smooth mag web page when compared with a matte one. When easy hits polished stone, a gigantic element bounces again in a unmarried route, which creates bright highlights. That might possibly be dazzling, however it also exaggerates an asymmetric substrate, a wavy cupboard run, or a crooked undercabinet pale rail. Honed, leathers, and other textured finishes scatter gentle more diffusely. Soapstone, leathered granite, or a honed quartz received't glare as plenty.
