Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the primary wheel, a smaller sized two-reel slots situated directly above the wheel-- known as the **Top Slot**-- spins concurrently.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot creates one random wheel sector (a number or a benefit game) and sets it with a random multiplier varying from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the primary wheel lands on the exact segment displayed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is applied to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payment is increased. If it is a perk video game, the multipliers within the bonus offer round are improved accordingly.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The primary attraction of the game is its four bonus rounds. Players who have positioned a wager on the specific benefit segment are approved entry into the mini-game when the wheel lands on it.



1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** A basic red and blue coin is turned by a device. Before the flip, each side of the coin is appointed a random multiplier. Whichever color lands face up figures out the player's payout.

2. Money Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** The screen shows a massive board featuring 108 random multipliers concealed behind shooting gallery symbols (like a duck, a cactus, or a target). Players are given a limited time to aim and fire a cannon at a sign of their choice to expose their multiplier.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sectors on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** A radiant puck is dropped from the top of a massive Pachinko wall filled with pegs. The puck bounces down randomly until it lands in one of the slots at the bottom, each consisting of a multiplier. If the puck lands on a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 section on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a lively, surreal virtual world including an enormous 64-segment wheel. The host selects among three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" sectors, enabling multipliers to rise to an incredible 20,000 x.

- **Diversify Your Bets:** Placing small wagers across several numbers and perk rounds guarantees that you remain in the action longer and do not miss out when a bonus offer round hits.
- **Prioritize the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, your house edge on the number sections (1, 2, 5, 10) is usually greater than the bonus rounds. Many experienced players choose to position small bets solely on the 4 reward segments to go after the video game's optimum payment capacity.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The fast-paced nature of live game programs can cause fast spending. Pick a fixed bankroll before you start playing and adhere to it, regardless of wins or losses.

- **Don't Chase Losses:** If you experience a cold streak where the wheel bypasses your bets, prevent the temptation to increase your stake sizes to recover lost funds rapidly.
