

The call was available in on a windy March morning from a center manager on the Southwest Side. Their local AHJ had actually flagged a passage opening throughout a routine assessment. The old fire door would certainly not drop, the fusible web link had actually been repainted to the point of uselessness, and the headroom was tight. They needed an option that pleased code, fit the room, tied right into their alarm, and did not stall procedures for a week.
