3. Diversify Your Case Selection

Prevent discarding your whole spending plan into a single high-tier case like *Operation Bravo* or *Recoil*. Rather, mix low-tier, stable-return cases with a couple of high-variance cases to balance the risk.

4. Make Use Of "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the lowest overall value wins) flips standard logic on its head. While it can be enjoyable, it relies completely on striking cheap, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with standard case-opening logic.
