- The "Covert" rarity is the rarest tier and constantly looks like the benefit item (knife or gloves).
- The portions revealed are approximate and can move somewhat with each case spot.
- Costs on the Steam Market typically go beyond the in-game cost for extremely sought-after skins.

3. Why These Cases Matter

3.1 Economy Influence

When a new case launches, the marketplace reacts within hours. The **Recoil Case**, for example, drove the rate of the *SCAR-20|Plan* (Mil-Spec) from £ 0.15 to £ 0.45 on the very first day. On the other hand, older cases like **Prisma** frequently see a price dip as supply stabilises.
